 - Baby and maternity clothing
- Diapers and baby supplies
- Bags, backpacks, briefcases, purses, luggage (please no holes)
- Art supplies (textiles, paints, frames, etc.)
- New or gently used books, toys, educational materials and stuffed animals
- Unopened toiletries and personal hygiene products including adult pads

Items Not Accepted

- Bicycles
- Small kitchen ware (pots, pans, plates and silverware)
- Used car seats or cribs
- Any type of broken item or item missing parts
- Expired food of any kind
- Opened, repackaged or prepared food items
- Furniture of any kind
- Linens (blankets, sheets, towels and sleeping bags)
- Pillows or mattresses
- House wares (lamps, vacuums, mirrors, etc.)
- Medical supplies or medications
- Large or small appliances
- Soiled or tattered clothing
- Knick knacks or figurines
- Computers or TVs
- E-Waste of any kind
